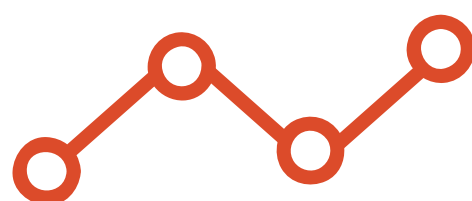
BUILDING POLICIES FOR VACCINATION

Develop a sustainable Vaccine Network and strengthen EU cooperation through diverse targeted groups: healthcare professionals, National Immunisation Technical Advisory Groups, European young people, Non-governmental organizations and Member States.



FUTURE SURVEILLANCE OF CROSS BORDER VACCINATION COVERAGE AND POSSIBLE CROSS BORDER CAMPAIGNS

Consolidate the interaction of Immunization Information Systems across Europe to improve vaccine surveillance potential and beget the conditions for transborder initiatives.



VACCINE SUPPLY AND PREPAREDNESS

Review past shortages and determine common principles for vaccine forecasting and establish a concept analysis for a EU data warehouse on vaccine supply and demand.



VACCINES RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Design a research priority-setting mechanism to encourage collaboration in vaccine/vaccination R&D and funding programmes.



VACCINE HESITANCY AND UPTAKE

Create a systematic analysis to oversee vaccine hesitancy and broadcast best practices, lessons learned and research-based knowledge to foster vaccine confidence.
